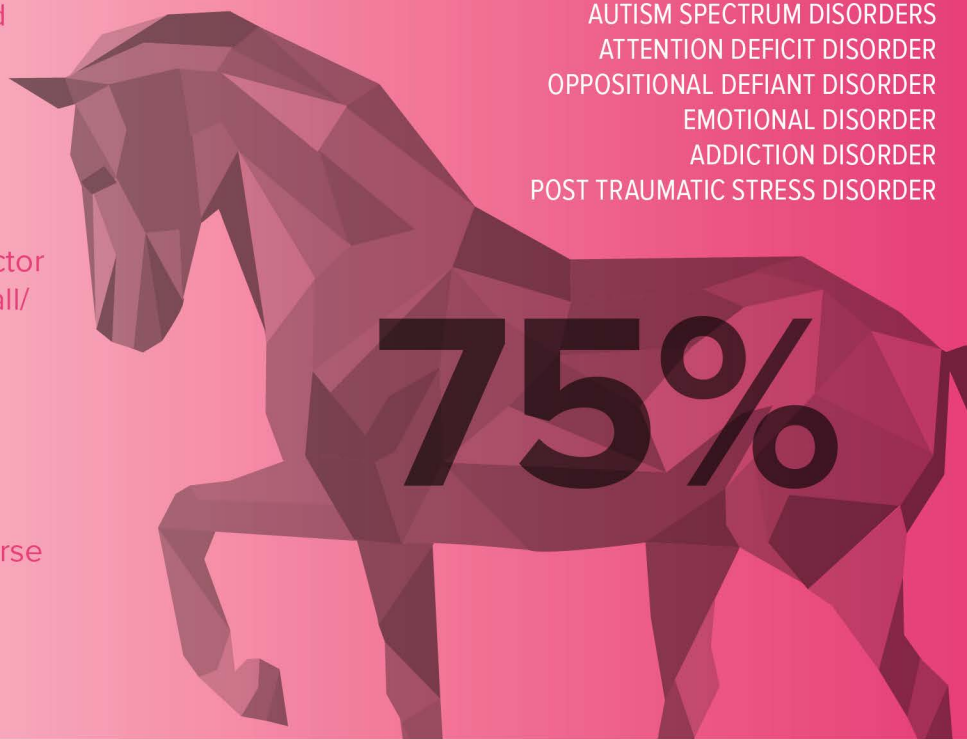

COMMUNITY NEED FOR SERVICES

In addition to having a diagnosis, many children are coming from impoverished conditions, thus creating a need for Hunkapi to provide respite, hope and safety. Hunkapi Programs is licensed under Title XIX as a Community Service Agency thus providing services to those covered under AHCCCS programs.



Hunkapi is a 501(c)(3) non-profit agency founded in September 2008 after being housed at Arizona State University for 10 years as the Alternative Intervention Research Clinic (AIRC). Every week over 250 children and adults come to Hunkapi for therapeutic riding lessons, equine-counseling, horse powered learning, executive coaching and riding lessons.
