HUNKAPI AGREEMENT FOR DONATION OF HORSE

The purpose of this agreement is to establish a common understanding between Hunkapi Programs Inc, a program of the non-profit, 501©(3), corporation Fed. ID No. 26-3902877, (Donee) and the owner (Donor) of the horse described below which is being donated to HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC..

It is UNDERSTOOD that HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC. is organized to provide recreational horse programs to people with special needs.

It is UNDERSTOOD that the animals used in the HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC. program must be safe, sound, healthy and compatible with the needs of the program.

The donor states that he/she is the owner and would like to donate the use of the horse named in above form, to HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC. for the use in its therapeutic and recreational horse programs. The donor warrants that he/she has disclosed injuries, illnesses, or other potential problems with the horse that would make the horse not fit for the program. The Donee states that they believe the horse to be acceptable and will accept the horse for a 90-day trial period. During the trial period HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC. will assume responsibility for any day-to-day care of the horse unless other arrangements have been made. Every precaution will be taken to assure that the animal receives good care and feeding. During this trial period the horse will be introduced to mounting ramps and any other conditions, which are required during the program. Reference from a veterinarian may be necessary. If, at the end of that trial period, the horse does not meet the needs of the program, the animal will be offered to or returned to the owner or, if appreciated, a good home will be found for the horse, as per agreement with the owner.

HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC. will not be held responsible for any veterinary expenses, resulting from pre-existing conditions that may incur during the 90 day trial.

If at the end of that trial period, the horse seems to meet the needs of the HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC. program, The Donor will be notified of its suitability and, if full donation is to take place, there will then be a transfer of hauling papers, registration papers, veterinary references and any other pertinent records. HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC. will in turn provide a Gift in Kind paperwork to be recorded with Hunkapi. A letter of acceptance of Gift will be sent. HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC. cannot provide an estimate of value for the purpose of donation.

If, for any unknown reason after full donation and acceptance, the horse becomes unusable, HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC., as the owner, will take whatever steps are necessary to dispose of the horse.



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The Donor acknowledges that he will not hold HUNKAPI PROGRAMS INC., its officers, servants, volunteers, participants, employees and agents, as well as the owner/agents of the property where the animal is kept or used, from all liability for personal injury arising from said horse during the trial period.

The undersigned donor shall pay all costs and attorney fees arising from any suit or legal proceeding which is brought by the undersigned contrary to the terms of this agreement.
